What do the Education Goals for Young Australians, as set out in the *Alice Springs (Mparntwe) Education Declaration* (December 2019), mean for curriculum? - How do I transfer these goals into my context? What do these goals mean for schools and teachers?

- Understand the breadth of scholarship that can inform teaching practice by examining evidence informed theory and practice.
- Connect curriculum goals, policy and ideas to classroom practice.
- Broaden your professional experience by creating a suite of professional tools.
- Networking—building relationships and learning from each other through exposure to different practices to achieve the Education Goals for Young Australians.
